To celebrate this year, we also wanted to take special initiatives to support the most marginalised in our society. We have developed our co-operation with Global Clinic (provides free medical and legal services to undocumented and mobile people) by putting up with them and with a private dental clinic acute dental care for those who are outside our regular social services. Following the example of Emmaus Åland, we are also working on developing a work pool for mobile and undocumented people together with Hirundo - an organisation supporting mobile people in the capital area.
